Prep with a Pro: Interview Prep, Tips and Strategies with Enterprise Holdings

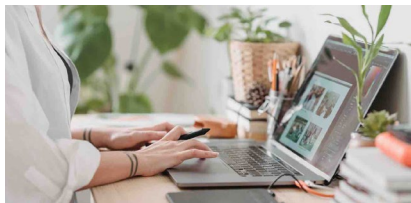

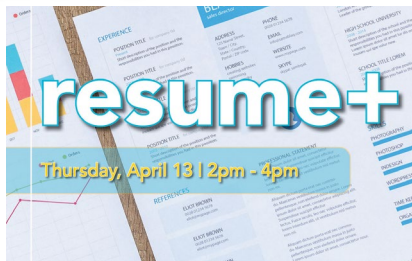
